Subordinating Conjunctions

There are many subordinating conjunctions. This list does not include all of them.

Learn to diagram subordinating conjunctions.

Example: I will eat broccoli **after** I eat this cookie.

A: after, although, as, as if, as long as, as much as, as soon as, as though

B: because, before, by the time

E: even if, even though

I: if, in order that, in case

L: lest

O: once, only if

P: provided that

S: since, so that

T: than, that, though, till

U: unless, until

W: when, whenever, where, wherever, while

Example: This cookie contains **neither** chocolate **nor** nuts.
